Proverbs 23:29-35 **Matthew 26:26-29**

Liquor ads have captured all the attention in advertisements everywhere.

Liquor is made through a distilling process.

Evangelist Billy Sunday, a presbyterian, called liquor, “Distilled Damnation”.

The **Context** of the passage regarding any wine will explain if the beverage is unfermented or fermented.

The Lord’s Supper is blasphemed every time Fermented Wine is used. Many churches and groups will use alcohol for the cup. Fleshly remembrance of The Lord Jesus’ Sacrifice and Resurrection, becoming a work of unrighteousness.

Mark 14:22-25 Luke 22:14-23 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

In these passages, never is fermented wine mentioned or used for The Lord’s Supper.

Passover. Unleavened is to be used.

Exodus 12:18-20, 13:7

No leaven. No Yeast. No Fermentation. No Distilling.

The usage of alcohol or fermented wine in the believer’s life is Sin.

This usage is blasphemous, wars against the soul of the believer. 1 Peter 2:11
